

## **NCPA Endorsement Process 2017 Election Cycle**

### **For Candidates:**

Candidates seeking NCPA endorsement must fill out the endorsement questionnaire available on the NCPA website.

Candidate questionnaires will be submitted to the steering committee to be checked for completion before being presented to the voting membership.

Candidates seeking endorsement will be invited to appear at a membership meeting to present their positions and answer questions. Endorsements require approval by two-thirds majority of voting members present at the membership meeting. Only one candidate per position will receive NCPA endorsement.

### **For Issues:**

Those wishing endorsement of issues or legislation must add that agenda item to a regularly scheduled membership meeting. Agenda items are submitted to the NCPA steering committee according to the approved NCPA Bylaws.

A spokesperson for the issue should be prepared to discuss at the membership meeting. Endorsements of issues/legislation require approval by two-thirds majority of the voting members present at the membership meeting.

*In the case of time-sensitive candidates/issues requesting NCPA endorsement, the Steering Committee may schedule a special membership meeting for that purpose.*
